CLUB EVENTS POLICY

The Caulfield Grammarians Football Club (**CGFC**) 'Club Events Policy' is in place to define what constitutes a 'Club Event' to assist organisers and the club in managing the risks of those events. The policy also aims to optimise benefits, and reduce risks, for club sponsors who make their venues available for Club Events.

1. 'Club Event'

A Club Event is an event that is:

- a. organised by the committee, or delegated club players or members; and
- b. is sanctioned by the Committee; and
- c. held in a:
 - i. club managed venue; or
 - ii. in a third-party event space (including a venue run by a club sponsor) and is expressly accepted as a CGFC event by that venues management.

Gatherings of players, officials, parents, members or supporters at a venue before, after or separate to an official club sanctioned event is not a 'Club Event'.

2. Code of Conduct

All attendees at a Club Event must abide by the 'CGFC Player and Official Code of Conduct' and 'CGFC Parent and Spectator Code of Conduct' (as applicable).

3. Breach of policy

Alleged breaches of this policy should be reported to the President of the CGFC Committee. A breach of this policy may result in disciplinary action from the CGFC Committee, at its discretion given the circumstances.
